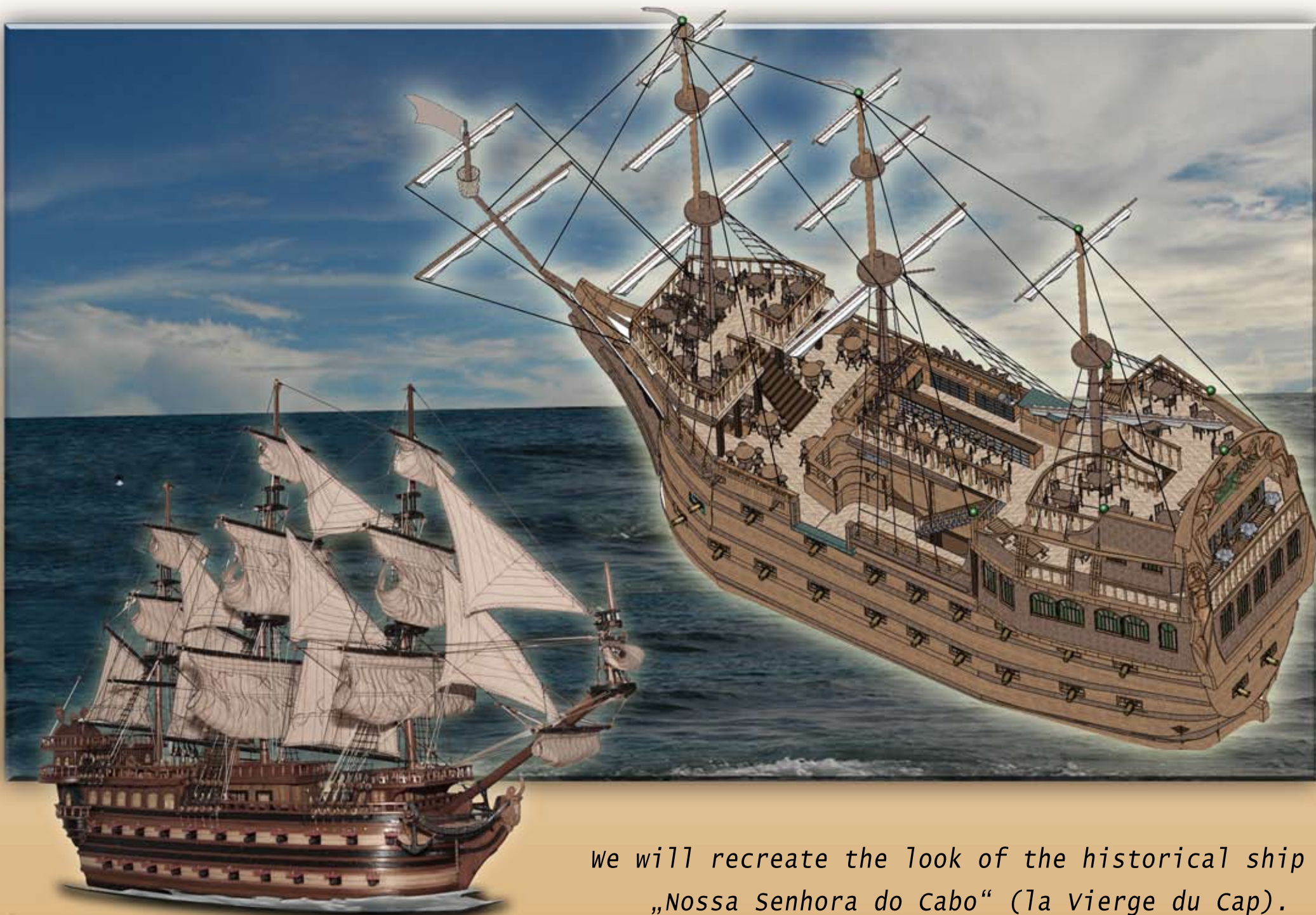

circa 300 seats

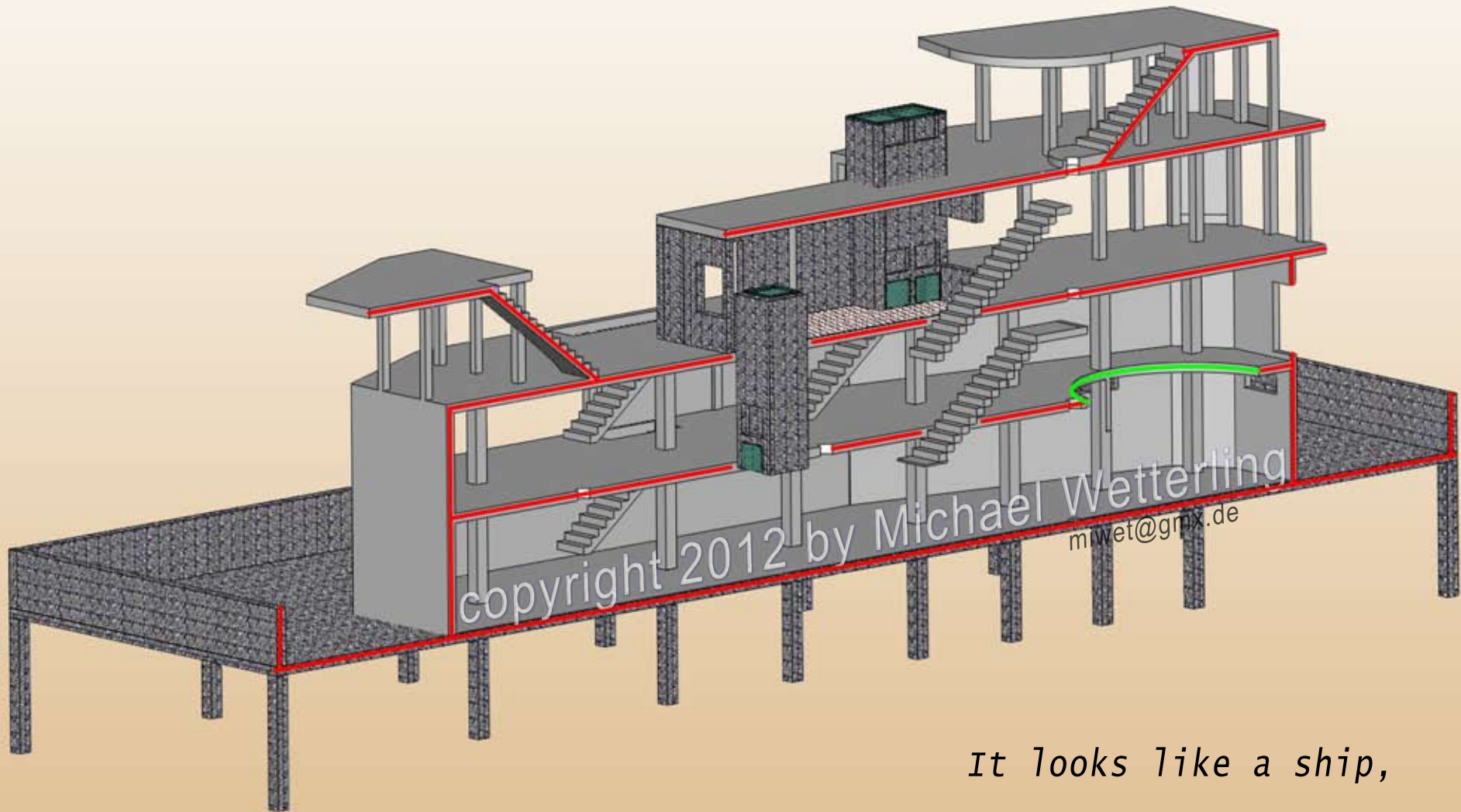
Equipment : one „open air restaurant“ with counter (90 seats)      one „open air pub“ with counter (140 seats)  
one „fine dining“ restaurant (76 seats)      one central kitchen with most recent technical standard  
two museum-showrooms in the lowerdecks

*It looks like a ship,*

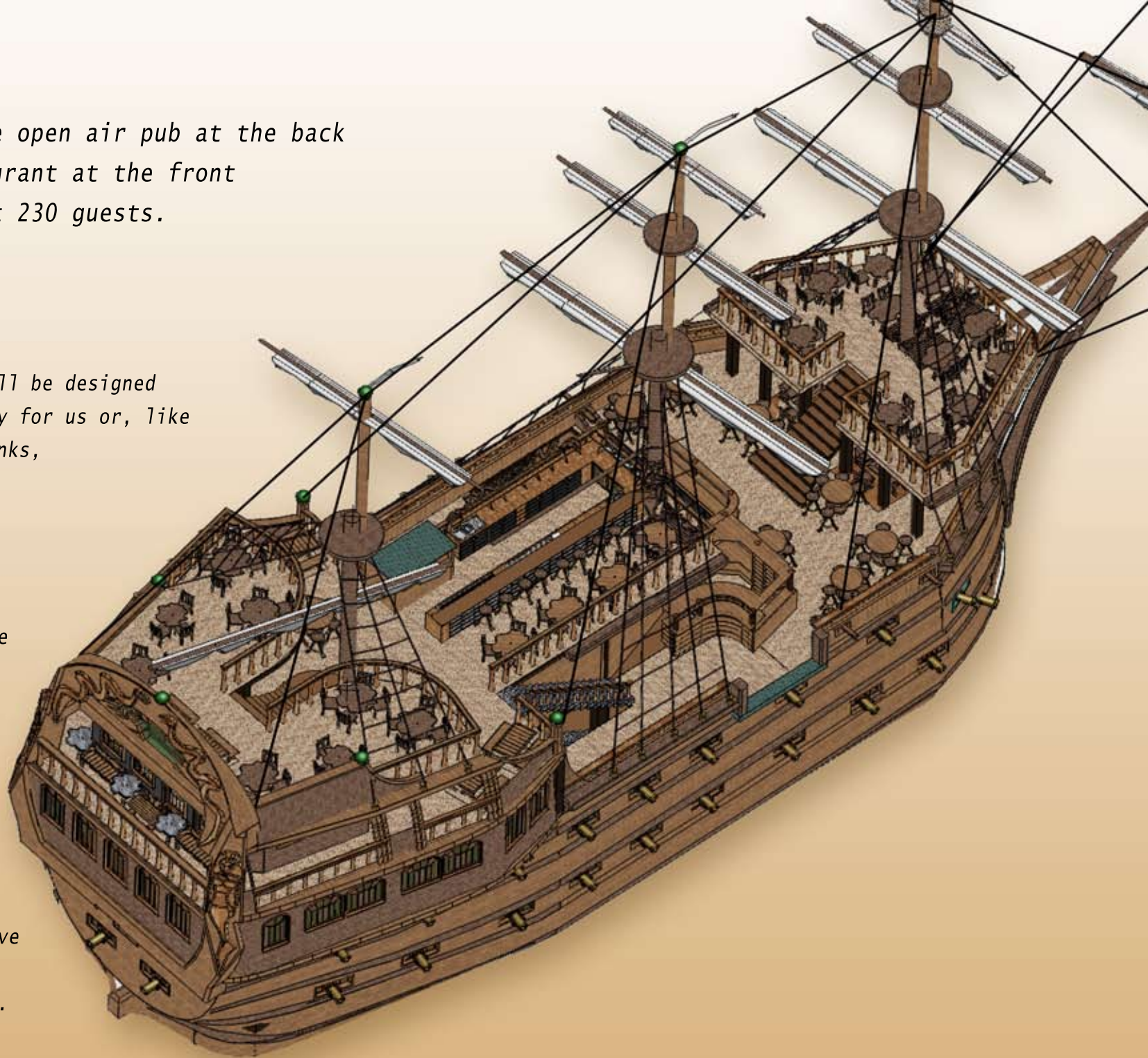
*but its core is a concrete building that may be build anywhere using  
standard procedures.*

The upper deck with the open air pub at the back and the open air restaurant at the front offers place for about 230 guests.

Here, too, all furniture will be designed by ourselves, produced only for us or, like the root wood tabled and banks, manufactured on our own.

With the help of our service lift warm meals can be served at every time.

We created two floors to give various optical charms and a beautiful view of the sea.

*we will create an specially atmosphere by the use of decoration and equipment.*



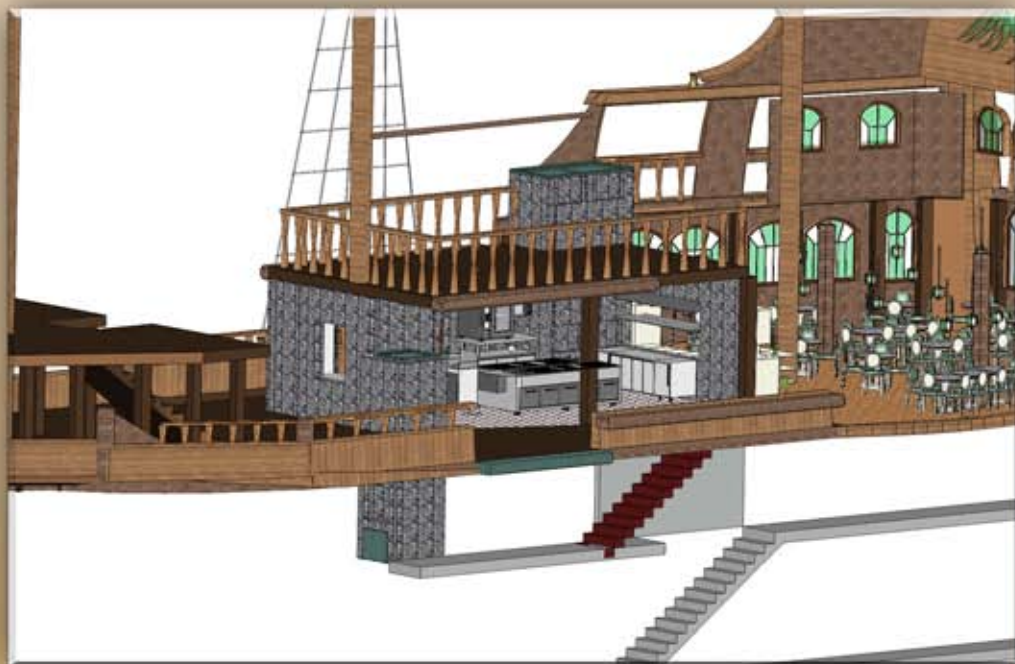


### *The two lower decks*

*The area around the heck inhabits a double floor for our planned museum and the souvenir shop.*

### *The central kitchen*

*The heart of the ship is the central kitchen in the middle of the upper deck.*

*Using a service lift the prepared ingredients are transported directly into the kitchen, cooked there and served to every side.*

*An additional double lift serves the bar on the floor on top.*

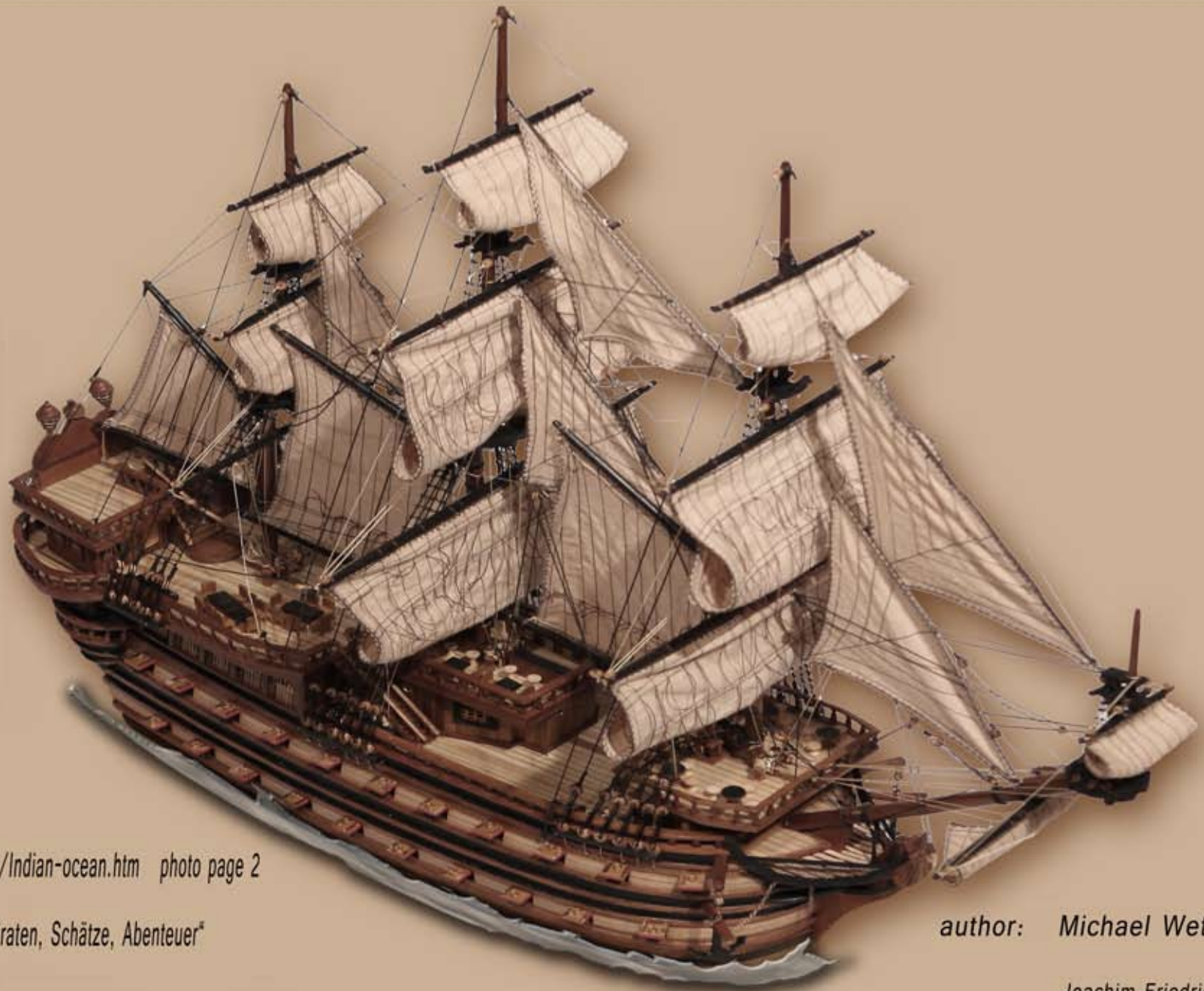
